- To demonstrate the importance of understanding Central American and Guatemalan historiography for better explaining historical events in the Guatemalan claim to and territorial dispute over Belize.
- NOT an examination of the broader territorial dispute or border issue itself or whether the treaty was a treaty of cession or not.
